provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). Any party that fails to attend or

participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in

default pursuant to the KAPA.²

A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.³ D.

E. Parties have 15 days from the date of electronic service of this Order to petition for

reconsideration.4

F. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the

purpose of entering such further orders as it deems necessary.
