ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. On August 1, 2017, the Commission issued a Penalty Order pursuant to K.S.A. 55-152 and K.S.A. 74-623, finding Operator committed one violation of K.A.R. 82-3-111 due to the Paulsen #1 well being inactive in excess of the time allowed by regulation without being plugged, returned to service, or approved for temporary abandonment (TA) status.¹ The Commission ordered the Operator to pay a \$100 penalty for such violation.²
 - 2. On September 5, 2017, the Operator filed a Request for Hearing.
- 3. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address matters pursuant to K.S.A. 77-516 517. The Commission also finds that a prehearing conference should be scheduled in this matter.

C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, and scheduling of a hearing with the Commission.

D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA), K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq*. Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default pursuant to KAPA.

E. A corporation shall appear before the Commission by a Kansas licensed attorney.⁴ BY THE COMMISSION IT IS SO ORDERED.
