

MOTION TO RESCHEDULE PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Staff requests that the prehearing conference in this docket, which was held on December 14, 2016, be rescheduled to a date and time in the second week of January. Staff has consulted with Operator, who is not opposed to the rescheduling. Staff was in attendance at the December 14th prehearing conference, but Operator was not. A few hours after the prehearing conference, Operator contacted Staff's Litigation Counsel, stating that he had been out of town for the last week, and had opened his mail just after the hearing had been held. The Commission's December 8, 2016, order setting the December 14, 2016, prehearing conference stated that failure to attend might result in default, but given the short timeframe between the order being issued and the prehearing conference, and the circumstances as relayed by Operator to Staff's Litigation Counsel, Staff does not think default would be an appropriate outcome in this case.
