# ORDER DESIGNATING PREHEARING OFFICER AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission). Having examined its files and records, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the following:

- 1. On October 22, 2018, Abercrombie Energy, LLC (Operator) filed an Application to authorize injection of saltwater into the Mississippi formation at the Brown #1-26 well, located in Seward County, Kansas.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. On October 30, 2018, a Proof of Publication was filed which stated The High Plains Daily Leader & Times published notice of the Application on October 21, 2018.<sup>2</sup>
- 3. On November 20, 2018, L.H. and Thais Brown filed a letter of protest and request for hearing, through their counsel, Will Wohlford.<sup>3</sup>
- 4. The Commission finds that a Prehearing Officer should be designated in this proceeding to address any matters listed in K.S.A. 77-517(b), and a Prehearing Conference should be scheduled.

5. Although a Prehearing Officer is designated, parties are still required to file pleadings with the Commission, and filings shall be made with the Commission's Docket Room before 5:00 p.m. on the date scheduled for service. Any electronic service received after the deadline set forth in the procedural schedule, or any filing made after 5:00 p.m. on the date scheduled for service, shall be accompanied by a Motion to File Out-of-Time.

### THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- A. The Prehearing Officer in this proceeding shall be Michael J. The Commission may designate other Staff members to serve in this capacity. <a href="mailto:The Commission directs electronic service">The Commission directs electronic service</a> of all filings in the docket to include service on the Prehearing Officer and mailed service of all filings to be directed to the Prehearing Officer's attention.
- B. A Prehearing Conference is scheduled for **Thursday, January 10, 2018 at 3:00 p.m.** by telephone. The conference call information is: telephone number (866) 620-7326, Conference Code PIN: 7632914771#.
- C. At the Prehearing Conference, parties shall be prepared to discuss deadlines for filing testimony and briefs, discovery procedures, scheduling of a hearing with the Commission, and any other issues that will promote the orderly and prompt resolution of this proceeding.
- D. At the Prehearing Conference, without further notice, this proceeding may be converted into a conference hearing or a summary proceeding for disposition of this matter as provided by the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act (KAPA). Any party that fails to attend or participate in the Prehearing Conference, hearing, or other stage of this proceeding may be held in default under the KAPA <sup>4</sup>
