**ORDER RESCINDING PENALTY**

Upon its own motion, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On November 28, 2017, the Commission issued a Penalty Order in this docket, requiring Operator to pay \$500, and to submit a complete, accurate well completion report and associated documents for the WU #1 well. Staff reports that a miscommunication between staff-members contributed to Staff's recommendation of a penalty. Absent the miscommunication, Staff would not have recommended a penalty. Operator has submitted the well completion report and all required documents, which have been processed by Staff.

2. Given the above, Staff recommends rescission of the Penalty Order.

**II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

3. Based upon the above, the Commission concludes that the November 28, 2017, Penalty Order in this docket should be rescinded.


**THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**
