## 3.4 Off-Premise Extensions

## 3.41 General

The Company will provide off-premise extensions (OPX), at customer request, under the following conditions:

- A. The OPX structure must be on the same physical property where the customer has an existing access line in service.
- B. The OPX structure must be within ½ mile of the existing access line location.
- (T) C. If either condition A. or B. preceding is not met, the customer must install a regular access line.
- D. The customer must install appropriately sized buried conduit for provision of the OPX facility. (N)
- The Company may, at customer request, bury conduit for the OPX facility subject to the (N) availability of Company employees and equipment.

## 3.42 Rates and Charges

(N)

- The rates and charges following provide for the additional facilities required and are in addition to other rates specified in this tariff, service connection charges and construction charges, when applicable.
- B. Provision of the OPX facility will be to a network interface. If the customer requests the Company to provide/install wiring beyond the network interface, the Company's standard wiring charges will apply in addition to the OPX rates and charges.
- (T) C. Customer provided conduit OPX facility installation (tech): (N)
  - 1. \$60.00 for initial hour.
    - \$12.50 per 1/4 hour after first hour. 2.
    - 3. \$2.50 per foot of cable.
    - D. Company provided conduit OPX facility installation (construction crew): <sup>1</sup>
      - 1. \$150.00 Trip Charge.
      - 2. \$100.00 for initial hour.
      - 3.  $$50.00 \text{ per } \frac{1}{2} \text{ hour after first hour.}$
      - \$2.50 per foot of cable.
- (T) E. OPX Monthly Rate per service \$3.00

These rates contemplate a typical facility placement. Should the Company encounter non-typical placement concerns (i.e. - rock, need to bore, etc.) the customer will be responsible for the additional costs.
