WESTAR ENERGY, INC.'S AND KANSAS GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY BUDGETS

COME NOW Westar Energy, Inc. and Kansas Gas and Electric Company (collectively

referred to as "Westar") and, pursuant to the Commission's Order Directing Westar to Submit

Budgets issued on September 29, 2015, requests approval of the five-year budgets for its current

energy efficiency programs.

1. On September 29, 2015, the Commission issued its Order Directing Westar to

Submit Budgets in the above-captioned docket. In that Order, the Commission stated:

Westar is ordered to submit budgets for all five of its current energy efficiency programs. The budget submissions should include breakdowns of costs associated with (1) Administrative Costs; (2) Incentives (if any); (3) Marketing; and (4) Evaluations. Westar's budgets are due by October 15, 2015.

Order Directing Westar to Submit Budgets, In the Matter of the Application of Westar Energy, Inc.

and Kansas Gas and Electric Company for Approval of Interim Budgets for Energy Efficiency

Programs, Docket No. 15-WSEE-532-MIS, ¶ 9 (Sept. 29, 2015).

2. Westar's four current energy efficiency programs are WattSaver Air Conditioning

Cycling, Energy Efficiency Demand Response, Simple Savings, and Energy Efficiency Education.

Westar is submitting five-year budgets with the breakdown of costs as stated in the Commission's

Order for each of these energy efficiency programs, attached hereto.

3. The tariff for Westar's fifth energy efficiency program – the Building Operator Certification (BOC) program – has expired and Westar is not currently seeking recovery of costs associated with the program. If recovery is sought in the future, Westar will formally apply to the Commission in a separate filing. However, because the Commission specifically listed this program as one for which Westar should file a budget, Westar is submitting a budget for the BOC program indicating that there will be no cost associated with that program recovered through rates.

WHEREFORE, Westar respectfully requests that the Commission approve its five-year budgets for its energy efficiency programs as requested herein.


