ORDER REINSTATING INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER OPERATIONS

The above-captioned matter comes on for consideration and determination by the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission), on Transportation Staff's motion. The Commission, being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

- 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,111, 66-1,112 and 66-1,114b, and amendments thereto, the Commission is given full power, authority and jurisdiction to supervise and control motor carriers, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f, doing business or procuring business in Kansas, and is empowered to do all things necessary and convenient for the exercise of such power, authority, and jurisdiction.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129a, 66-1,130, and 66-1,142b, and amendments thereto, the Commission may suspend operations, revoke, or amend certificates, and initiate sanctions or fines against every motor carrier and every person who violates any provision of Kansas law in regard to

the regulation of such motor carriers and persons, or who fails to obey any order, decision, or regulation of the Commission.

3. Pursuant to K.S.A. 66-1,129(a)(7), the Commission has adopted motor carrier transportation regulations (K.A.R. 82-4-3f) consistent with the federal motor carrier safety assistance program and other federal requirements concerning transportation of hazardous waste.

II. BACKGROUND

- 4. Arnold Bonilla d/b/a Bonilla Module Hauling, of Liberal, Kansas (Carrier), is a motor carrier as defined in K.A.R. 82-4-3f that operates commercial motor vehicles in intrastate commerce.
- 5. Carrier is registered as a motor carrier with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) and operates under USDOT Number 2202788.
- 6. On March 14, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Intrastate Motor Carrier Operations,¹ other than such motor carrier operations excepted from the Commission's regulation under K.S.A. 66-1,129, due to non-compliance with a Penalty Order issued on August 30, 2022.² The Penalty Order assessed Carrier a \$300 civil fine for failing to pay its 2022 Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) fees. The Commission's Penalty Order is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Order.
- 7. On April 3, 2023, Carrier submitted payment of the \$300 civil assessment and submitted payment of their 2022 UCR fees. Transportation Staff (Staff) confirmed the payments have been made as of that date and determined the carrier was now in compliance with Kansas motor carrier safety statutes, rules and regulations pursuant to the above-referenced Penalty Order.

On April 5, 2023, Staff filed a Motion to Reinstate Intrastate Motor Carrier 8. Operations on Carrier.

III. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

9. Based on Staff's Motion and Carrier's compliance, Staff recommends the Commission reinstate Carrier's Kansas motor carrier operations.

IV. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Commission finds it has jurisdiction over Carrier because it is a motor carrier as 10. defined in 49 C.F.R. 390.5 and as adopted by K.A.R. 82-4-3f.
- Based on the available facts, the Commission finds that Staff's recommendation to 11. reinstate Arnold Bonilla d/b/a Bonilla Module Hauling's motor carrier operations is reasonable.

THE COMMISSION THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

Arnold Bonilla d/b/a Bonilla Module Hauling's intrastate motor carrier operations A. are hereby reinstated.
