ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On December 11, 2002, Atmos Energy (Atmos) filed a motion for an extension of time to respond to Staff's evaluation of the annual report filed by Atmos. The motion states that counsel will need additional time to prepare a response due to the holiday season and vacations by Atmos personnel. Atmos asks for an extension until January 6, 2003. The Commission finds that this request is reasonable and grants the extension.

A party may file a petition for reconsideration of this Order within 15 days of the date of this Order. If service is by mail, 3 additional days may be added to the 15-day time limit to petition for reconsideration. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.




