**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (“Commission”). Having reviewed its files and records and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds as follows:

1.       On May 1, 2006, the Commission issued its Order Addressing Citizens’ Utility Ratepayer Board’s (“CURB”) Complaint, Petition to Intervene, and Motion to Defer the Effective Date of Proposed Public Switched Network Recovery Charge and Suspend Proceeding and Closing Docket. On May 1, 2006, CURB filed a Petition for Reconsideration of Commission’s Order.
2.       On May 26, 2006, the Commission staff (“Staff”) filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff requested that its time to respond be extended from May 26, 2006, to June 2, 2006. Staff states that it needs the additional time because of the press of other business. Staff states that CURB and Sage Telecom, Inc. do not oppose the extension.
3.       The Commission finds that the extension of time is reasonable and should be granted.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:**

A. The Motion for Extension of Time to File Staff's Response to the Petition for Reconsideration is granted. The Response is due on or before Friday, June 2, 2006.

B. The parties have fifteen days, plus three days if service of this order is by mail, from the date this order was mailed in which to petition the Commission for reconsideration of any issue or issues decided herein. K.S.A. 66-118; K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 77-529(a)(1).

C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.
