ORDER ACCEPTING THE VPS KUSF FISCAL YEAR 28 AUDIT SELECTIONS

The above-captioned matter comes before the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas (Commission) for consideration and determination. Having examined its files and records, the Commission finds and concludes as follows:

- 1. Vantage Point Solutions (VPS) is the current Administrator for the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF). The KUSF Administrator has statutory responsibilities for collecting and auditing information regarding telecommunication service providers receiving funds from the KUSF. It is also entrusted with the duty to verify funds generated for the KUSF. K.S.A. 66-2010 provides, in part, the Administrator's duties and responsibilities as follows:
 - (b)(1) Collecting and auditing all relevant information from all qualifying telecommunications public utilities, telecommunications carriers or wireless telecommunications service providers receiving funds from or providing funds to the KUSF;
 - (b)(2) verifying, based on the calculations of each qualifying telecommunications carrier, telecommunications public utility or wireless telecommunications service provider, the obligation of each such qualifying carrier, utility or provider to generate the funds required by the KUSF.
- 2. VPS sent a letter to the Commission on July 23, 2025, identifying 16 carriers proposed to be audited for KUSF Fiscal Year 28. The VPS letter of July 23, 2025, is attached hereto as an Exhibit and incorporated by reference. The proposed selections are in conformity with

the Selection Criteria set forth in the Order of July 15, 2025, and appear as Attachment 1 to the VPS letter. These sixteen (16) carriers account for approximately \$11.06 million or 30.13% of the total \$36.7 million in assessments contributed to the KUSF.

3. Based on the VPS letter dated July 23, 2025, the Commission finds the VPS Audit Selection List of the sixteen (16) carriers should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COMMISSION ORDERED THAT:

- A. The VPS Audit Selection List of sixteen carriers set forth in Attachment 1 to the VPS letter of July 23, 2025, is hereby adopted and approved.
- B. Any party may file and serve a petition for reconsideration pursuant to the requirements and time limits established by K.S.A. 77-529(a)(1).¹
- C. The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties for the purpose of entering such further orders as it may deem necessary.

On July 1, 2025, Vantage Point Solutions (VPS) filed its proposed Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) Fiscal Year (FY28) Carrier Audit Selection Criteria and Audit Procedures to use for the FY28 carrier audits.

Vantage Point Solutions, Inc. (VPS) is filing its proposed Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) contributors it recommends be subject to a carrier audit for the KUSF Fiscal Year of March 1, 2024, through February 28, 2025 (FY28).
